Since its customers have done most of the obvious destinations, the focus is on finding the best-quality riding in terms of roads and scenery in less explored areas from South Africa to New Zealand to Canada and Europe. But founder Cari Gray loves South America and frequently takes clients to Chile and Argentina. She is especially enamored with the Argentine wine country around Mendoza in the west and the Valle Calchaqui in the northwest, noting that, "The smooth pavement and ever-evolving, stunning red rock landscapes of the Quebrada de las Conchas valley between Salta and Cafayate make it one of the best roadbike rides in South America — if not the world." Gray & Co. trips operate on a "no margin for error" philosophy that puts guest satisfaction above all else, with an unusually high guide- and driver-to-client ratio, dedicated mechanics, premium carbon bikes, and a truly white-glove touch.
